

Mar. 21, 2016 – Alphyn Construction Inc.

Defendant: Alphyn Construction Inc. – Toronto

Charge: Part I Provincial Offences Act summons for an offence under the *Ontario College of Trades and Apprenticeship Act, 2009*, sec. 4 – employing or otherwise engaging individual to engage in compulsory trade without a Certificate of Qualification.

Summary: On Jul. 24, 2015, Ontario College of Trades enforcement officers conducted an inspection at a new residential build located in Burlington. One individual was confirmed to be performing work of a sheet metal worker (308A) while not having a Certificate of Qualification or being a member of the College.

On Mar. 21, 2016, Alphyn Construction Inc. pleaded guilty to the charge under sec. 4 of the *Ontario College of Trades and Apprenticeship Act, 2009*.
