The Director, of the Boiler and Pressure Vessels Regulation, *Technical Standards and Safety Act*, 2000, S.O. 2000, c. 16, pursuant to his authority as provided for in Section 36.(3)(c) of the *Technical Standards and Safety Act*, 2000, hereby orders the following:

- 1. Notwithstanding subsection 2.(2)(i) of Ontario Regulation 220/01 (Boilers and Pressure Vessels), the regulation does not apply to refrigeration piping that has a capacity of three tons (11 kW) or less of refrigeration or a capacity of five tons (18 kW) or less of refrigeration in an air conditioning system.
- 2. This Order is effective on July 1, 2007.
