Defendant: Canadian Home Heating Inc.

Charge: Part I Provincial Offences Act summons for an offence under the Ontario College of Trades and Apprenticeship Act, 2009, sec. 4 – employing or otherwise engaging individual to engage in compulsory trade without a Certificate of Qualification.

Summary: On May 30, 2016, Ontario College of Trades enforcement officers conducted an inspection at a residence in Mississauga. The enforcement officers determined that one individual was performing the work of a residential (low rise) sheet metal Installer (308R) without proper qualifications, in particular, the individual did not hold a Certificate of Qualification and was not apprentice in the trade working pursuant to a registered training agreement.

On Aug. 9, 2016, Canadian Home Heating Inc. failed to appear for an early resolution meeting and was convicted of the charge and the court imposed a monetary fine, including a victim fine surcharge.
