

# July 25, 2016 – Fahrhall Mechanical Contractors Limited

**Defendant:** Fahrhall Mechanical Contractors Limited

**Charge:** Part III *Provincial Offences Act* summons for an offence under the *Ontario College of Trades and Apprenticeship Act, 2009*, sec. 4 – employing or otherwise engaging individual to engage in compulsory trade without a Certificate of Qualification.

**Summary:** On June 7, 2016, Ontario College of Trades enforcement officers conducted an inspection at a LaSalle residence regarding work that was performed on June 3, 2016. The enforcement officers determined that one individual was performing the work of a refrigeration and air conditioning systems mechanic (313A) without proper qualifications, in particular, the individual did not hold a Certificate of Qualification and was not apprentice in the trade working pursuant to a registered training agreement.

On July 25, 2016, Fahrhall Mechanical Contractors Limited was convicted of the charge and the court imposed a monetary fine, including a victim fine surcharge.
